

## **Street Moves: Veteran Adviser McCaslin Joins Paulson Investment**

New York (Dow Jones) – Broker-dealer Paulson Investment Co. has named veteran financial advisor Doug McCaslin a senior vice president of investments in Portland, Ore.

McCaslin brings with him a book of wealthy clients and will play a key leadership role on the company's Pacific Northwest sales team, the Paulson Capital Corp. (PLCC) subsidiary said in a statement.

McCaslin began his career more than 20 years ago as a financial consultant with Kidder, Peabody & Co. The firm was acquired by PaineWebber in 1994, which then merged with UBS AG (UBS) in 2000. McCaslin has held the title senior vice president of investments for the last 15 years and, according to Financial Industry Regulatory Authority's public records, was registered with UBS until May 2009.

A native Oregonian, McCaslin graduated from Stanford University and received a master's of business administration from UCLA Anderson School of Management, Paulson said.
